



RECIPES BY RHONDA

BANANA CREAM SHORTCAKE

1 cup shortening

1 1/2 cups sugar

3 large eggs, room temperature

2 tsp banana extract

1 tsp vanilla extract

2 ¼ cups all-purpose flour 3 tsp baking powder

½ tsp salt

1 cup 2% milk

PUDDING

2 cups cold 2% milk

1 pkg (3.4 oz) instant banana cream pudding mix

2 large bananas, cut into 1/4 in slices

TOPPING

1 cup heavy whipping cream

1/4 cup confectioners' sugar

3 TBSP Brandy

½ cup miniature semisweet chocolate chips



Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In a large bowl, cream shortening and sugar until light and fluffy, 5-7 minutes. Add eggs, 1 at a time, beating well after each addition. Beat in extracts. In another bowl, whisk flour, baking powder and salt; add to creamed mixture alternately with the milk, beating after each addition just until combined. Pour into a greased 13 x 9 in baking dish.

Bake until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean, 35-40 minutes. Cool completely in dish on a wire rack.

In a large bowl, whisk cold mild and pudding mix for 2 minutes. Let stand until soft-set, about 2 minutes. Fold in sliced bananas. Spread evenly over cooled cake.

In another large bowl, beat cream until stiff peaks form, 5-7 minutes. Beat in confectioners" sugar and brandy; spread over pudding mixture. Cover and refrigerate for at least 1 hour. Before serving, sprinkle with chocolate chips.

A meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Wauneta, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 6:30 p.m. on **July 8, 2025,** at the Village Office.

Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Chairman Johnston publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review.

Present: B Kramer, C Walgren, K Kerchal, R Einspahr, P Johnston.

Guests: John Krajewski (JK Energy Consulting), Edward Dunn (West Central Nebraska Development District (WCNDD) Executive Director), and RaNae Richardson (WCTC Administrator).

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Imperial Republican on July 3, 2025. Notice of this meeting was simultaneously given to the Chairman and all the Trustees. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

John Krajewski, JK Energy Consulting (JKEC), presented the 2025 Cost of Service/Rate Design Study. JKEC reviewed the financial performance of the Wauneta Electric Utility to develop rates that reflect the cost of service and accomplish other goals established by the Village. JKEC recommends that Wauneta implement an 8% rate increase on Oct 1, 2025 and an 8% rate increase on Oct 1, 2026. And further recommends the Village conduct an updated study to assess needs after that.

Board approved the minutes of the regular meeting of the Village Board of Trustees, held on June 10, 2025, and approved the minutes of the special meeting of the Village Board of Trustees, held on June 18, 2025.

Board approved the Treasurer's Report (June) and approved bills (July) as presented.

Kerchal, Einspahr and RaNae Richardson reviewed the Nursing Home Financial Reports for May 2025 with the Village Board and gave a report on the Committee meeting.

Board approved the proposed increase to the WCTC Daily Level of Care Rates (each level increased by \$10.00) effective September 1, 2025.

Board approved WCTC employee wage increases, based on the recommendation of Administration.

Reviewed the Sheriff's Report for June 2025.

Edward Dunn, Executive Director, gave a presentation on the Nuisance Abatement Program, which WCNDD offers.

Board approved a proposal for the expansion of the walking path at the park, to connect the path from the top playground to the gazebo and then on to the west side of the existing walking path. The expansion will be concrete, and the Village will pay for an ADA path from the walk to the west side of the tennis courts (\$2,314.00) and the remainder will be funded with memorial funds (\$12,104.00).

Board approved the request for a Special Designated Liquor License, received from Good Times Bar & Grill LLC, for Harvest Fest, to be held outdoors at 318 N Tecumseh, on Saturday July 26th, 2025, from 6:00 am to 11:59 pm.

Discussion on ongoing nuisance properties.

Johnston provided an update on the committee meeting with the Chase County Commissioners and Wauneta EMT's regarding Ambulance Building renovations.

Clerk's Report was given by Skelton. Superintendent's Report was given by Lawless.
